Today, Sunday 27th June, Clodagh Ingram will be ordained as a Deacon in the Cathedral, and will become (as from today) our curate at St Barnabas. Clodagh has been training for ministry on the West of England Ministerial training course over the past 3 years. She will be a Deacon for the first year of her curacy, before her ordination as a priest.
